Summary of the role:	The Art & Design Technician plays a pivotal role in the Art & Design Department by assisting the Head of Department and teaching staff through the preparation of materials, classrooms and general organisation.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:	 Key Responsibilities as directed by the Head of Department: To be available and ready to compile the daily diary of tasks at 8.30 a.m. every morning. To prepare equipment and teaching areas for practical classes. To maintain a safe and tidy working environment at all times. To work alongside the class teacher in lessons providing assistance when needed. To assist pupils working under the direction of the teacher outside lesson times (in clubs and after school) when the teacher is not present in the room. To assist with co-curricular clubs and open studio sessions in the holidays. Assisting with art displays. To come into school at the end of the summer holidays to ensure that the orders are checked and put away, enabling the department to begin teaching on the first day of the new academic year.
